2) "Seniors: Emergency Preparedness and Community Wellbeing" Kendra Taylor and Renee de St. Croix, Planning and Development, North Vancouver City. (30-35 min)

Community Well Being Strategy is a 10-year plan and conversation on how to best create a "City where everyone belongs.... and thrives."

Renee de St. Croix and Colleen Alexander presented the Community Wellbeing Strategy to the group, with a focus on Seniors. North Vancouver city planners will be reaching out regularly, to the community to find ways to connect.

Action ideas to date: Seniors Housing, Connectedness and reducing Social Isolation, seeking funding and partnerships to support the strategy and awareness to diverse seniors' populations.

Specific Action for seniors includes: Ensuring access and inclusion, communications and outreach, age-friendly cities and what that means and setting up programs for collecting stories/experiences/indigenous teachings and history.

"Hey Neighbor" Community program, Victoria, B.C. HNC is a group of practice partners that build social connections and resilience. 100% of neighbor's feel more connected and less lonely.

NVC will be looking for nonprofit partnerships that will be interested in working together on creating a similar model in apartment buildings and complexes in North Vancouver.

JBCC seniors' programs are going well. Fitness and bus trips are well attended.

• Silver Harbour Seniors Activity Centre – Annwen Loverin

There are now 42 of the 70 programs back up and running.

Income tax clinics are starting soon. SH will be offering in person clinics but seniors attending must show proof of vaccination.

Parkgate Community Centre – Kelsey Grass

Most programs are up and running and are well attended.

Tax clinic is starting up soon. By appointment only. Seniors will drop off information. No proof of vaccination is required. Staff and volunteers will be provided with PPE and will follow Health protocols.

SOS – The Seniors Directory is in its final proof and will be hot off the press soon.

Pamphlets have been updated.

Better at Home – Looking for drivers. Currently offering transportation to medical appointments. Seniors would like to expand this to offer rides to other services.

Information and Referral Services are available in an outreach capacity. Staff and volunteers are going out to seniors to support them with support in filling out forms.
